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SUMMMER STREET FESTIVAL COMING TO DOWNTOWN

Monthly Squamish Street Market kicks off Father's Day

SQUAMISH, BRITISH COLUMBIA- An exciting brand-new event is coming to town this summer. The Squamish Street Market is setting up shop over three blocks and two parks in the heart of downtown Squamish for four Sundays, once a month from June to September 2018. There will be up to fifty street vendors, ten food trucks, Kid Zone, music, entertainment, contests and locally sponsored craft- beer garden. A Taste of Squamish Theme Park will showcase the best of Squamish's emerging craft-beverages, food scene and heart- pumping activities as well as a Real Estate and Development Showcase for those interested in getting a foot into the residential or commercial market.
